## Fees & Awards

Regional Classes: \$35.00 per class or \$150 per division. Cattle charges not included.  
CATTLE entries (Working Cow Horse & Roping) are due by **March 10**.  
If a total of **25 entries** are not received by March 10, all cattle classes will be cancelled **AND** all fees refunded. On the entry form, please provide daytime, evening & cell phone so notification can be made.

Late Fee entries - will be accepted after March 10 for all classes at \$70.00 per class or \$225.00 per division. (Cattle fees to apply.)

LATE FEES CATTLE - if more than 25 total entries are received by March 10, additional cattle entries will be accepted at \$70.00 per class plus cattle fees.

Residents in Alabama, Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi & Tennessee are eligible to participate. Exhibitors residing outside Region Nine may compete if they file and are approved for hardship consideration. The hardship form must be filled out & approved with AQHA prior to the show. For complete Regional Championship rules and hardship applications go to [www.aqha.com/showing](http://www.aqha.com/showing) & click on Regional Championship.

Classes that are individually worked will be run concurrently with Regional classes. Example - halter, western riding, etc. Classes such as Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure will be run separately.
