DAILY SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Join Arkansas Quarter Horse Association for their fall ride at the beautiful Rafter D Ranch. Established in 1981, the ranch is located in the foothills of the beautiful Ozark Mountains of north central Arkansas. Rafter D Ranch has miles of well-marked, hand cut trails suitable for all levels of riders. The trails wind through deep woods, across creeks and over scenic hilltops for a true Western experience. The Rafter D has 40 spacious campsites with water and electric as well as a state of the art showerhouse. Arrive at the Rafter D anytime after noon Friday. Those that desire can ride on their own Friday afternoon and we'll eat Mike's famous Cowboy Stew dinner at 6 pm. Afterwards sit around the campfire and renew old acquaintances and make new friends. After a full breakfast with biscuits & gravy, eggs and sausage/bacon, coffee and juice Saturday morning, Mike will lead riders on a 4 or 5-hour ride, returning to camp shortly after noon. After Mike's crew serves a hot lunch get ready for horseback fun and games in the afternoon. You'll work up a good appetite and enjoy a Kansas City Steak dinner around the campfire. Mike has arranged first-class entertainment that will allow for dancing or just more visiting. Sunday morning we'll have another full breakfast followed by a Cowboy Church Service.
